There have been numerous thefts from the Carfest site on Broxton Parish Council. The thefts have mainly been opportunistic whereby victims have lefts vehicles insecure or property has been taken from tents which are not the most secure. There have been 2 thefts from secure sheds whereby tools have been taken from the Tattenhall area. There was 1 occasion at the recycling centre in Tattenhall where 2 bikes were stolen, quickly recovered, and 1 male was arrested in connection with this.
